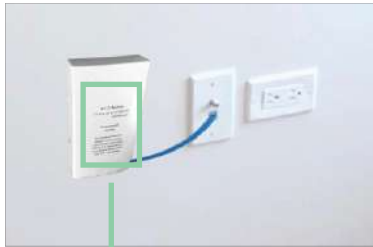


## Connecting to your Wi-Fi | Instructions



### Step 1

Locate the Wi-Fi Access Point in your apartment living room, which will be mounted and secured to the wall. This Wi-Fi Access Point supports both 5 GHz and 2 GHz, so if your device (i.e. smartphone, tablet) supports 5 GHz, it is **highly recommended that you use the 5 GHz network that is specific to your apartment.**



### Step 2

To connect to your apartment Wi-Fi, simply open Wi-Fi settings on your device and search for your network name, which is labeled on the Access Point, along with the password. You will have the choice of two apartment-specific Wi-Fi frequencies to connect to: a 5 GHz and a 2 GHz option. Both will accept the password unique to your apartment, although we recommend you select the 5 GHz connection if visible, since this frequency will maximize your Wi-Fi speed.



### Step 3

Alternatively, you may connect using an Ethernet cable. Insert the Ethernet cable from any computer or device to one of the four ports on the underside of the Wi-Fi Access Point or to any of the Ethernet wall jacks in each bedroom. **We recommend plugging in any device that is near the Access Point, especially any device used for streaming.**
